Dear Sir/Madam,

As foreseen in the Council Regulation No 199/2008, the Commission herewith asks Member States to provide aggregated scientific data from within their *National Data Collection* programs as detailed in Commission Decision of 6 November 2008¹ to support scientific advice in EU fisheries.

Tables 1 and 2 in Annex 1 give an overview of the data requested for submission under this call. Table 1 concerns data requested for the years 2008-2011 (collected under the DCF legislation). Please note that the years requested for each parameter type in table 1 vary depending on expected availability. Table 2 concerns data relating to 2002-2007 (collected under the old DCR legislation), which takes exactly the same form as previous data calls. In addition to fleet segment level data, national totals are also requested for all parameters.

Time schedule

Member States are kindly requested to supply the data as specified within **one month**. The Commission Services cannot accept data delivered after this deadline, in view of the tight schedule for processing and analysis.


Member States have to use the agreed procedure for transmission of data (by uploading onto the JRC server).

Each Member State requires a password in order to submit data. These passwords remain unchanged from the previous call for economic data. If a Member State no longer has a record of their password, they should contact the JRC data submission team by emailing datasubmission@jrc.ec.europa.eu

We also remind that Member States are legally bound to submit data under the Council Regulation mentioned above, as stated in article 8.5.c. a failure to do so might have implications on the funds allocated to your future data collection program, a situation that the Commission would like to avoid.
